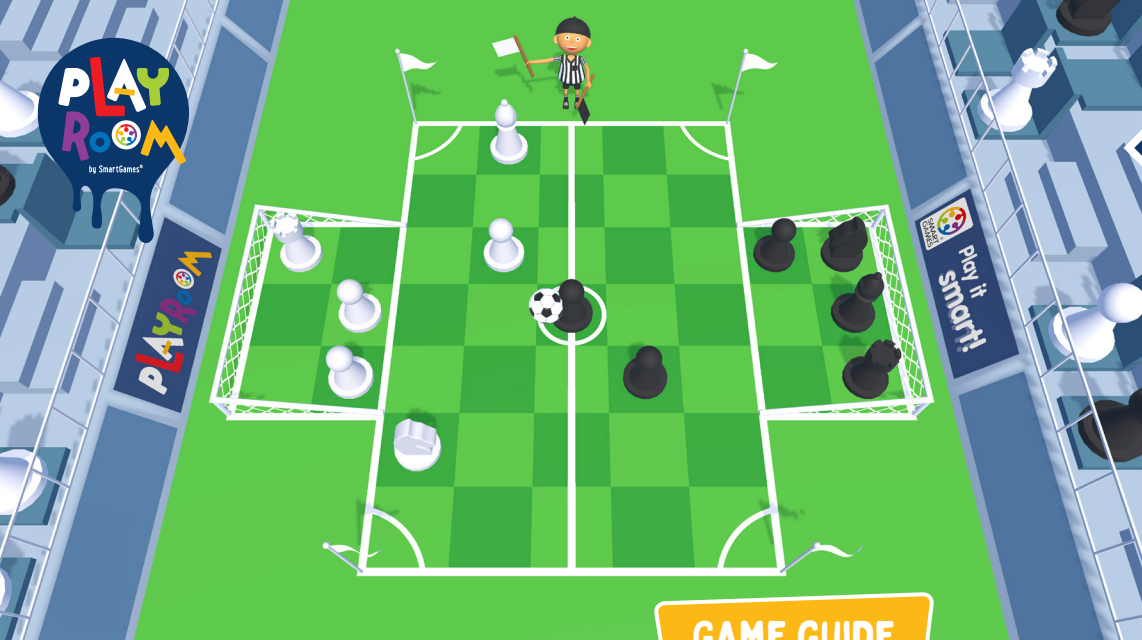

Chess and soccer: the perfect “match.” Play a game of ChessFC against your friends and be the first to score the golden goal. With the right strategy, you’ll lead your chess team to victory!

Although Chess FC combines the rules of chess and soccer, you can only win the game by being the first to score a goal. Just like in real chess, you move different pieces across the field. These chess pieces have the same limitations as in the actual game; for example, a rook can move vertically and horizontally, while a knight can make two and a half steps in any direction. By capturing your opponent’s chess pieces, you increase your chances of scoring the first goal. If you master the rules of chess, you’ll be able to win Chess FC smoothly, but even without knowledge of chess, you still have a chance to win—with some practice, of course.



WHY USE CHESS FC IN YOUR CLASSROOM?

Chess FC is a game for two players that combines the world of soccer with the world of chess in a unique match. The goal of the game is to be the first to score a goal by strategically moving chess pieces across the field. You control a few traditional chess pieces, but the main objective remains scoring the first goal. Chess FC is an exciting game where logical thinking and planning ahead play a crucial role. Fun is guaranteed!

You can use Chess FC in various ways in your classroom. Here are a few examples for inspiration:

Introducing Chess: Chess FC offers a playful introduction to chess. Since the virtual chess pieces move the same way as real chess pieces, you can use this game as a starting point. Have the students practice on real chess boards in addition to Chess FC and teach them chess step by step.

Create a New Game: The uniqueness of Chess FC lies in its combination of two different games into a brand-new game. Challenge your students to come up with their own new game by combining two different games. What if you combined Monopoly with gymnastics? Let their imagination run wild, and who knows, they might come up with the most popular game in the school!

Soccer with New Rules: Just like creating a new game, it's also fun to come up with new rules for an existing game. Divide the students into small groups during the next physical education class and let them modify the rules of soccer. This will undoubtedly lead to creative matches.
