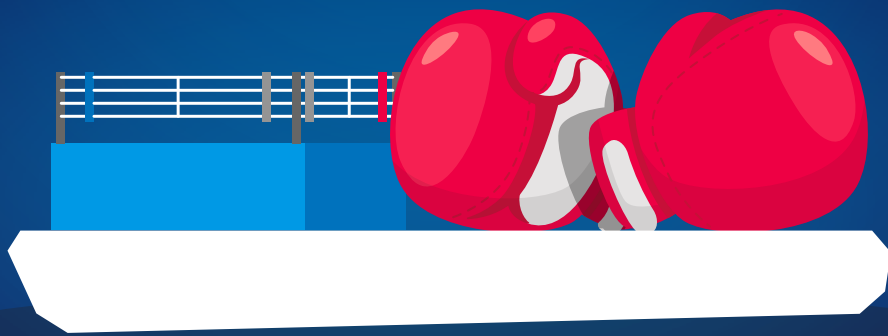




BATTLE GUIDE



First you must be logged in as a teacher at playroom.smartgames.com

Skip this step if you have already added all your students.

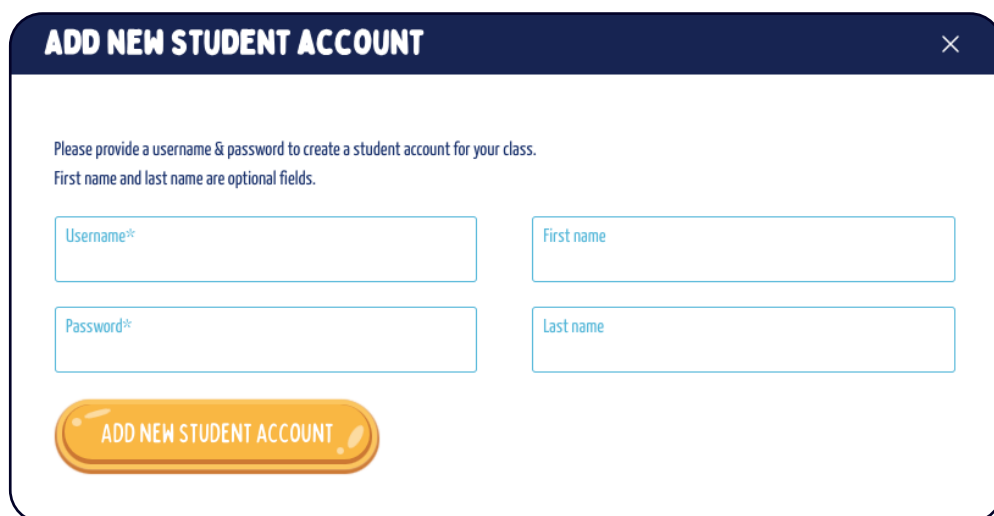
STEP 1

ADD STUDENTS TO ACCOUNT

- Go to “students” (under “my classroom”).



- Click on “add new student account” and fill in the necessary information.

STEP 2

CHOOSE A BATTLE

- Go to “playroom battle” (under “my classroom”).



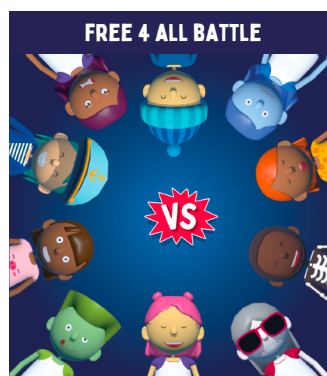
- Click on “start your playroom battle”.



- Choose which type of battle you want to play.



This is a team battle: brainiacs vs smartypants. You divide the students into 2 groups and they compete in team.



This is an individual battle. The students play against each other, each for themselves.

- Set the time for how long the battle should last.



Choose which game(s) your students play during the battle or choose “all games”.



Click on “continue to last step”.

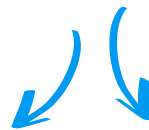
STEP 3

JOIN AND PLAY

Now your battle has been created and the students can join:

- All students log in with their **own account** and go to **Playroom** (“play now” on the site).
- All students now click on the “**Playroom battle**” symbol in Playroom.

next step:



If you have chosen the team battle:

The students click on “brainiac” or “smartypants” and are added to the battle.

If you have chosen the individual battle:

The students are automatically added to the battle.



If the student can't join automatically, the student can fill in the Battle ID (found on the battle screen of the teacher in the next step) and join manually.

You can now see the number of students increasing.



- Click on "let's battle" to open the battle page.



- When all students are in the battle, you can click on "start battle" so that the time starts running. The students receive a notification and can start playing!



During a battle, students can only play games. All the other features like changing your avatar and room are disabled so they can focus on playing the games.
